he eagerly-awaited, annual appointment with the Salone del Mobile has been put off till 2021. It is too soon to draw any conclusions - how furniture design will react to ongoing problems will only really be clear next spring - but what is certain is that our relationship with the idea of home is changing. The home is becoming a place for comfort-driven innovation, especially now that more and more activities are being concentrated within people's own spaces, as is the case with remote working. Desks and suspended worktops, chests of drawers and containers, even partitions transformed into furniture, are therefore all useful for the purpose. We make a virtue out of necessity: our homes have been transformed into offices, new scenarios have been created. The dining room becomes a work station, the bookcase provides space for office necessities

ourselves, with an idea of wellbeing that reaches out beyond the interior. This can be seen in the marked orientation of in/outdoor collections - contract oriented, suitable for the export and hospitality market – that want furniture to be increasingly hybrid.

This was noted recently by architect and entrepreneur Giulio Cappellini when he spoke of a "new domestic nomadism", in observing the hybrid role of rooms, with the industry producing objects that are more flexible, also in how they are used, and lightweight. The organisation of outside spaces (small balcony, garden, penthouse) is delegated to furniture that transcends internal-external barriers, because the pleasure taken in home spaces is now experienced whatever the season, facilitated by bioclimatic pergolas and gazebos (real rooms exposed to light) that ensure conditions of climatic well-being, on a par with, or even superior, to domestic interiors. Systems for furnishing balconies including horticulture, horizontal or vertical, may be called on to aid In refurbishing and redevelopment projects, while the types of furniture employed, generally speaking, are more sober and versatile: foldable, stackable, removable.


